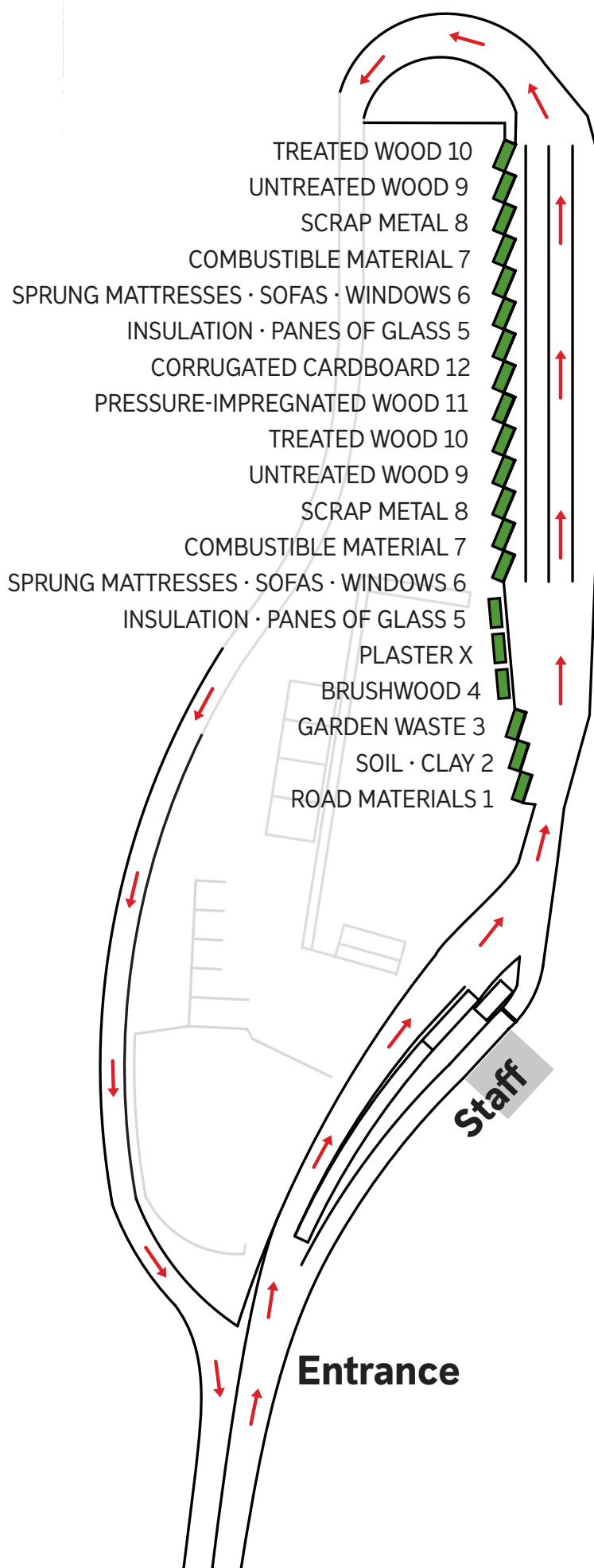

SORTING INSTRUCTIONS

At our recycling centre, the containers are arranged in this order and with numbered signs. You come to container no. 1 on the left-hand side first. The right-hand side begins with no. 13, further on in the area.

Please note: Container nos. 5-10 are double containers and are located at the end of the route, see area layout on next page.

12 CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

11 PRESSURE-IMPREGNATED WOOD

10 TREATED WOOD

Varnished, glued and painted wood, particle boards and Masonite.

9 UNTREATED WOOD

E.g. pallets.

8 SCRAP METAL

Bikes, office chairs, lawnmowers drained of petrol/oil

7 COMBUSTIBLE MATERIAL

Polystyrene, plastic, textile, tar paper, foam rubber, books, envelopes.

6 SOFAS • WINDOWS

Sprung mattresses and other bulky combustible items.

X PLASTER

4 BRUSHWOOD

Coarse garden waste, branches, trees. Empty bags/cartons!

3 GARDEN WASTE

Leaves, grass, compost, hedge clippings. Empty bags/cartons!

2 SOIL • CLAY

1 ROAD MATERIAL

Bricks, gravel, concrete, stone, clinker. Empty bags/cartons.

31 ASBESTOS

Contact staff.

FRIDGES • FREEZERS **28**

Fridges and freezers from households, emptied and clean. Refrigerated display counters and drinks coolers – please contact staff.

X PVC

HAZARDOUS WASTE **26**

Mercury, ammonia, acid, pesticides, hardener, photographic chemicals, unknown chemicals, fire alarms.

25 WASTE OIL

Empty yourself.

24 PAINT

ELECTRONICS **23**

TVs, computers, microwave ovens, vacuum cleaners, phones, cables.

LIGHT BULBS • FLUORESCENT TUBES **22**

Intact light bulbs, fluorescent tubes, low-energy light bulbs. No packaging!

SMALL BATTERIES **21**

CLEAR GLASS **20**

COLOURED GLASS **19**

PLASTIC PACKAGING **18**

Containers, bottles, canisters made of plastic, and household polystyrene.

METAL PACKAGING **17**

Cleaned jam jars, foil packaging as well as tubes and other metal packaging items with no residues of hazardous waste.

PAPER PACKAGING **16**

Packaging items made of cardboard, paper bags, wrapping paper.

NEWSPAPERS **16**

Newspapers, journals, brochures and advertising flyers.

14 TYRES WITHOUT RIMS
