At Aröd recycling centre, all of the containers are fitted with numbered signs to denote how you should sort your waste. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact a member of staff.

Ovens, washing machines, cooker fans, tumble dryers, drying cabinets.

**2** INSULATION • PANES OF GLASS **2**

Sanitary porcelain and ceramics. Waste for landfill.

**3** ROAD MATERIAL **3**

Bricks, gravel, concrete, stone, tiles and clinker.

**4** BULKY COMBUSTIBLE MATERIAL **4**

Upholstered furniture, windows, polystyrene, plastic, textile, tar paper.

**5** PRESSURE-IMPREGNATED **5**

**6** WOOD **6**

Varnished, glued and painted wood, particle boards and Masonite.

**7** SCRAP METAL **7**

Bikes, office chairs, lawnmowers drained of petrol/oil.

 **FRIDGES • FREEZERS** **8**

Fridges and freezers from households, emptied and clean. Refrigerated display counters and drinks coolers – please contact staff.

**9** GARDEN WASTE **9**

Leaves, grass, compost, hedge clippings. Empty bags/cartons.

**10** BRUSHWOOD **10**

Coarse garden waste, branches, trees. Empty bags/cartons.

 **PAPER PACKAGING** **11**

Packaging items made of cardboard, paper bags, wrapping paper.

 **NEWSPAPERS** **12**

Newspapers, journals, brochures and advertising flyers.

 **PLASTIC PACKAGING** **13**

Containers, bottles, canisters made of plastic, and household polystyrene.

 **METAL PACKAGING** **14**

Cleaned jam jars, foil packaging as well as tubes and other metal packaging items with no residues of hazardous waste.

 **COLOURED GLASS** **15**

 **CLEAR GLASS** **16**
